

EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN

Upon recognition of emergency event: inspect scene, assess situation, designate Person In Charge (PIC).

IF, it will take longer than 5 minutes to contact the victim, injuries require immediate medical attention, search and/or rescue is necessary, OR there are not enough people to handle the situation: activate EMS, call 911, provide nature and location of emergency (and rescue need if tree, water or powerline landing).

THEN, PIC meets EMS at designated location, offers assistance, informs pilots how to help EMS.

OTHERWISE, PIC coordinates non-EMS response, transporting persons with minor injuries to local hospital emergency room and recovering/removing aircraft from area.

PIC documents relevant facts and reports emergency to appropriate entities, including USHPA if emergency involved a pilot or aircraft.
